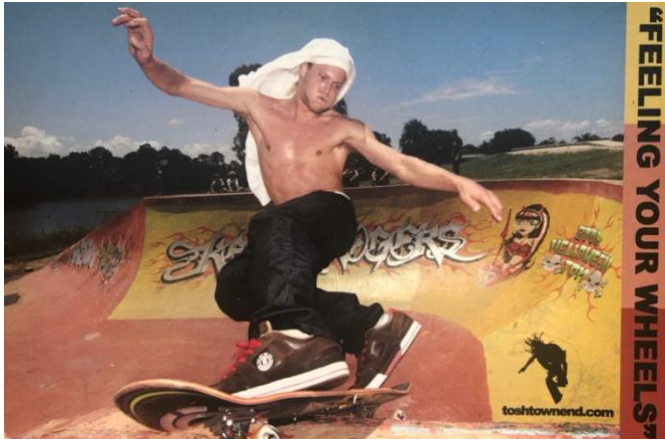


## Tosh Townend | Professional Skateboarder



Tosh Townend is a professional skateboarder from Huntington Beach, California. He is married to entrepreneur and Shark Tank alumna Nicole Townend. They have a 10-year-old daughter, Jemmaly. He turned pro at 16. Tosh got sponsored by Element when he was 11 and was on the team until 2008. Tosh Townend's father is Australian Peter (PT) Townend, the 1976

surfing world champion. His father would have boards around the house and would let Tosh ride them. Tosh first followed his father's footsteps and surfed. He started surfing in the National Scholastic Surfing Association when he was seven years old and became the NSSA Junior Middle School California Champion in 1996. However, when PT was working at Rusty, Tosh started skateboarding more and at 11, he won the California Amateur Skateboard League in the 11 and under division, and at 12, the 14 and under division. These wins, and the sponsorships that followed, propelled him into his professional skateboarding career. Tosh co-owner of a grass roots company called Good Skateboards based in Huntington Beach.
