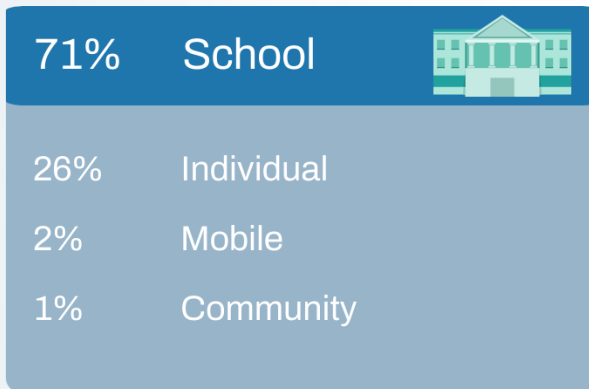

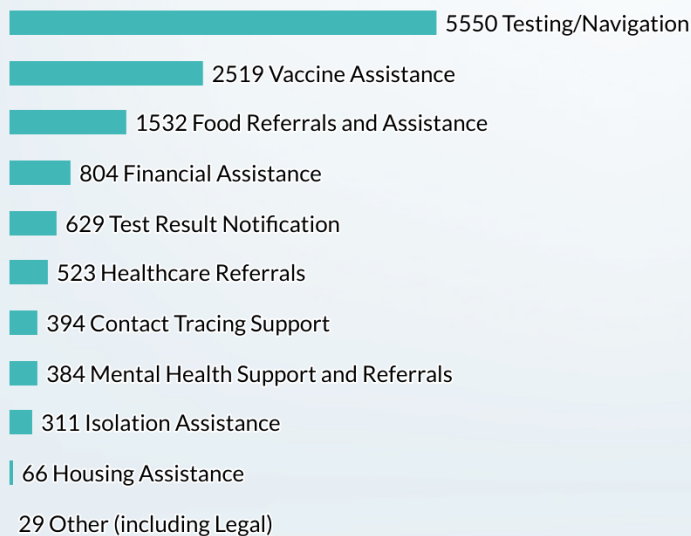

Mr. Francisco V. is a single father of a 13-year-old teenager and a 20-year-old young man. Francisco V. fell ill with COVID-19, and he was laid off from his job as a gardener. He was unable to work. Due to medical complications, he had two toes amputated. He does not receive help from the government nor unemployment. A co-worker referred him to the COVID-19 call center, and I was able to establish contact with him. I helped him fill out an application for financial aid. After two weeks, he received a check. He continues to receive help from the food bank, as groceries are sent to him every week. He is very grateful for the help that LHA has provided him.

One of my family members tested positive for COVID but had no symptoms. He said not to worry and we could still have dinner because he wasn't contagious. A representative from the API taskforce educated me about COVID and I learned that even if someone doesn't have symptoms, they could still be spreading COVID. I'm so glad we didn't spend Christmas together and decided to stay home. I gave the brochures in Vietnamese to other family members so they would know more about COVID. – Xuan N.

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
