COVID-19 VACCINATION OPTIONS IN ORANGE COUNTY

1 Primary Care Provider or Pediatrician's Office

You may schedule a vaccine appointment through a Primary Care Provider or a Pediatrician's office that your child or family is already familiar with. Consider contacting them first!

2 Local Vaccination Sites
