Partners include Elected Officials, School Districts, Churches, Community Based Organizations, and other partners. Conducting Town Halls, facilitating vaccine registration, and coordinating community efforts has continued to build capacity to address COVID-19 and increase community awareness of additional support services available to the communities throughout Orange County.

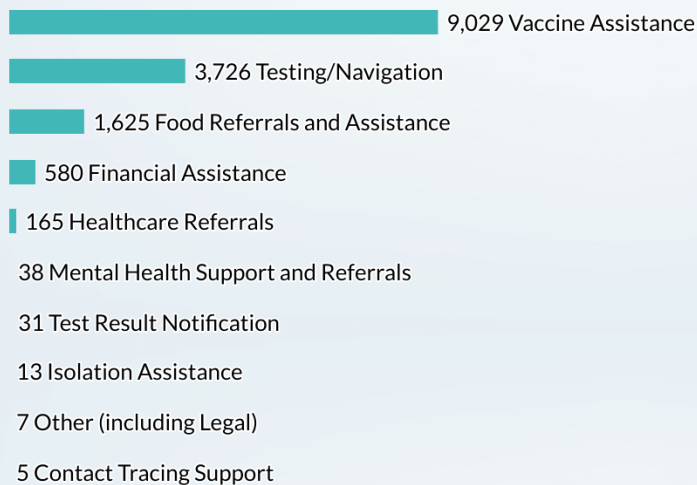
